the dead.



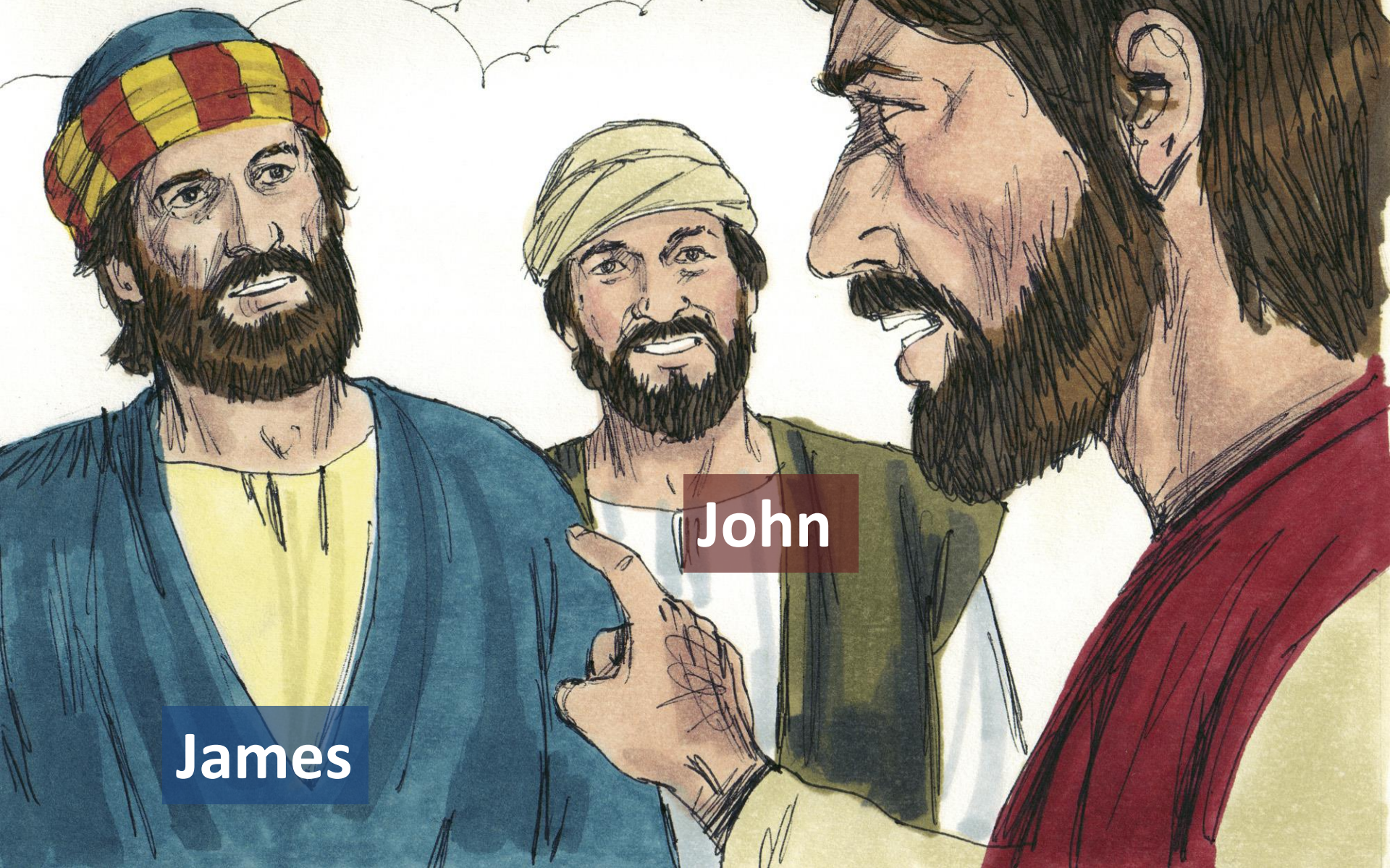

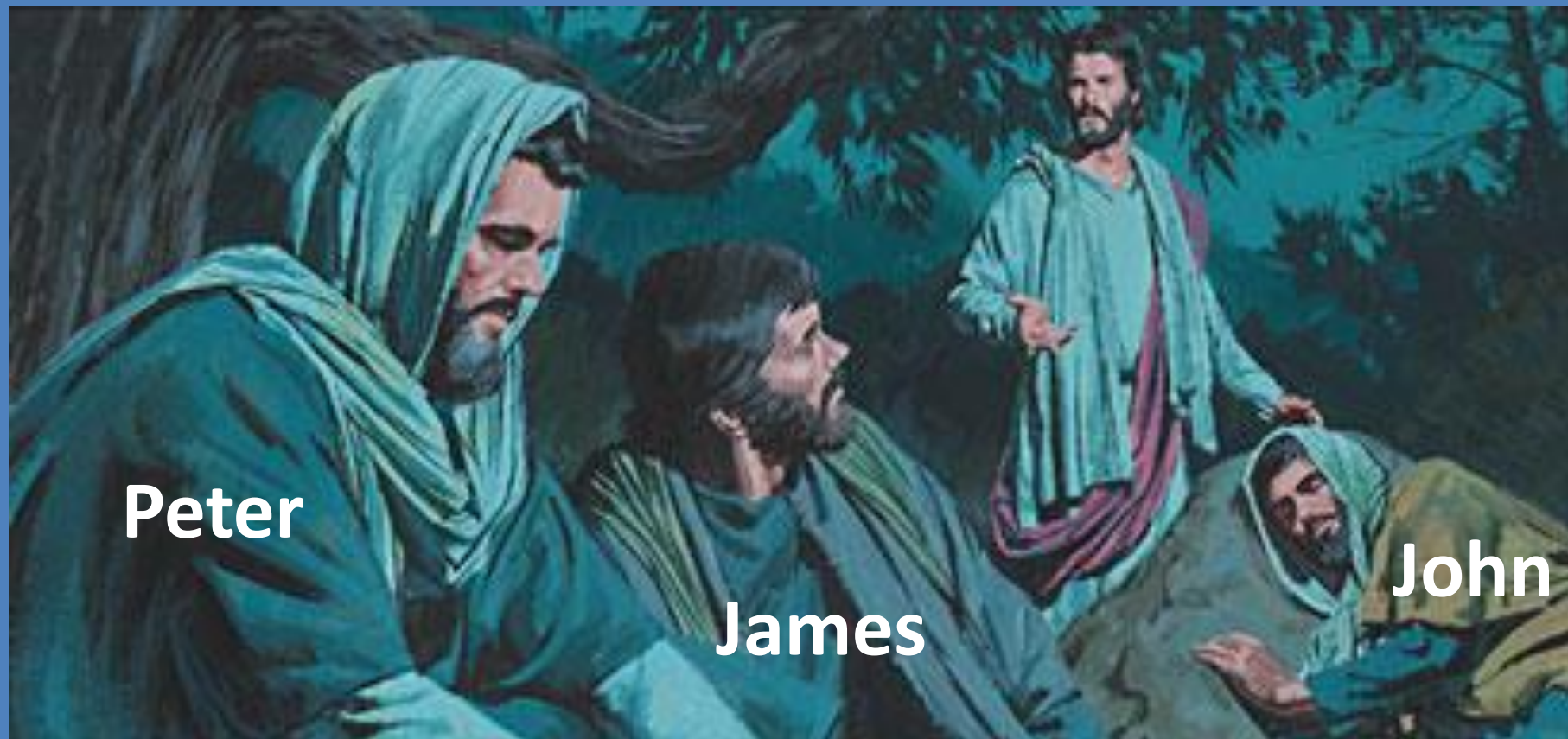

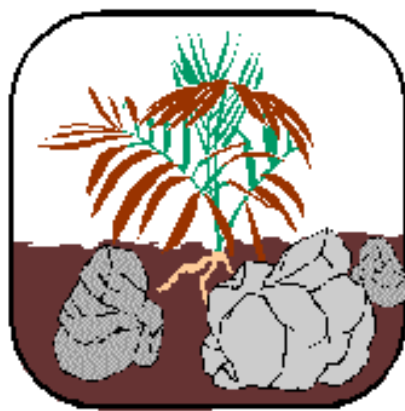
